

INFORMATION IN RELATION TO CANBERRA ACT AUSTRALIA FOR WBC#4 – OCTOBER, 2020

Canberra, Australian Capital Territory (ACT) is the capital of Australia, an area of 2,400 square kilometres, surrounded by New South Wales. Canberra is inland 280 kilometres from Sydney, 660 kilometres from Melbourne and 150 kilometres from the South Coast. The airport is 5 to 15 minutes from the centre of Canberra depending on traffic.

Canberra boasts a myriad of tourist attractions, including Parliament House, The Australian War Memorial, National Museum of Australia and The Royal Mint to name a few.

Canberra and the surrounding area can provide every facility including over 1,000 restaurants from fast food outlets to fine dining of all cuisines.

ACCOMMODATION:

The range is a short distance from New South Wales (NSW) so accommodation in Canberra or Queanbeyan is available close to the range. All types of accommodation from tents, caravan parks, apartments, motels and hotels with ratings from 2 to 5 stars are within 15-20 minutes from the range. On range there is ample room for caravan or tent camping.

RANGE PROPER:

Is flat terrain therefore very easy to set flags. 30 concrete topped fixed benches all dual handed. Lock up secure armoury where competitors can lodge their firearms for safe keeping. Separate Range hut for Scorers and Officials.

The SSAA ACT Club House is a large building that contains toilet and shower facilities. Competitors will have plenty of space to set up their equipment, rest and accommodate non shooting travel partners. Lunch, morning and afternoon teas

as well as snacks will be available in the kitchen that forms part of the Club House.

Plenty of vehicle parking conveniently placed adjacent to all facilities and close to the range proper.

The SSAA ACT range is suitable for wheelchair or disabled persons with designated car parking, ramps, paths and ambulant facilities.
