



Minutes of the meeting of Rimfire Delegates to the WBSF

Held at the CLUB TIR PRECISIÓ

Carrer Edison 31 CP 08243 MANRESA, Catalonia-Spain

On Tuesday, July 24th , 2018

The meeting was opened by Francios Luciani the Rimfire President of the WBSF, who welcomed the delegates to the meeting.

Present were delegates from :- Australia, Belgium, France, Germany, UK, Italy, Luxembourg, Namibia, Netherlands, Portugal, South Africa, Spain and Malta.

Contact Information was sought from all the delegates present in order to keep the list up to date.

There were no apologies for absence.

Minutes of 2016 Meeting were accepted and passed unanimously.

Recognition of the world record set by John Radford set at the 2014 WRC 1 in France. A certificate commemorating this achievement, was presented to the Australian Delegate to pass to John.

A vote was taken on New Country Memberships for Slovenija, Mongolia, Iceland, India, Iran.

It was agreed by all, at the suggestion of the President, that these memberships be on a conditional basis until such time as shooters from these countries, took part in a future match.

Rimfire WBC4 in 2020: Bids were accepted from Australia (Canberra) and Malta to host this event. Each country delegate made a short presentation to support their respective bids.

The South African Delegate asked each country delegate about the ease of taking rifles into their countries.

It was decided by secret ballot that the bid from Malta would be accepted on a vote of 8/3. Provisional on the Range in Malta being ready.

The Australian Delegate then asked for their bid to be considered for 2022. This was accepted by the President.

General Business :

Motion to limit maximum number of windflags (France)

It was agreed to limit the number of flag poles in a lane to a maximum of nine at future events. On a vote of 12/1 against, with no abstentions.

**Motion to allow adjustment of barrel tuner during match (Australia)
It was made clear that this was only to be allowed provided the bolt was removed.**

The motion failed on a vote of 1/8 against with 2 abstentions.

Motion to rewording Rule B.9 regarding non-metallic substance in sandbags (Australia)

It was agreed to reword rule B.9 by the insertion of the word 'mineral' in front of the word sand, in order to clarify the current use of heavy sands as being with the rules.

Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to reduce time limit to 20 minutes (Australia)

This motion was held over, for further consideration until the next delegates meeting after a 6/6 vote. The President declined to cast his deciding vote.

Motion to admit more than one organization per country to WBSF Rimfire World Championships (Australia)

It was agreed that, in cases where the full bore representative body to the WBSF had no interest in rimfire shooting and the rimfire shooters of these countries had no access to the WBSF rimfire competitions, that one additional rimfire representative body would be allowed.

A maximum of 2 representative bodies, one for centrefire and one for rimfire in such cases was specified and only where a single body did not cover both.

The motion was carried by 11/0 with 1 abstention.

Motion for accreditation of Delegates in writing (Australia)

It was agreed that delegates to future meetings would be accredited, by their respective rimfire federations, in writing, in advance of the meeting.

The motion was carried 10/0 with 2 abstentions.

Motion to change the restrictive dimensions of the Bench height given in Rule B.13 (Australia)

This motion was withdrawn after a brief discussion.

Any other business

None.

The meeting was declared closed by the President.
